## FoodCare Orange: Quality food at a great price

### Are you struggling to make ends meet?

Food Care Orange provides affordable quality fresh food and groceries to individuals and families on low incomes in the Orange area.

Every week at Food Care Orange we have a range of cheap frozen and fresh food, grocery and personal items.

You can always expect to find:

- Fresh fruit & vegetables (whatever is in season)
- Milk
- Bread
- Dried goods (pasta, rice, noodles)
- Canned food (beans, spaghetti, tomatoes)
- Health & beauty products (shampoo, soap, toothpaste)

FoodCare Orange purchases grocery items

from Food Bank Sydney. These items are often discontinued lines, an over production or close to best before date. Our donated food usually includes milk, bread, fruit and vegetables.

Food Care Orange tries to provide quality food as cheaply as possible. We charge an administration fee to cover costs such as freight from Sydney and transport to pick up donated food.

You decide whether you want to purchase five items for \$5.00 up to a maximum of 30 items for \$30.00.

## Client Forums: A Focus on Maintenance



In July, Housing Plus held Client Forums in Mudgee, Orange and Bathurst focusing on how we provide maintenance and repairs.

We had a marvelous turnout for all forums, and heard some great ideas about how we can enhance our maintenance services.

We asked for feedback related to; the experience of reporting maintenance and repairs, time frames in which maintenance and repairs are completed, and the quality of work provided by contractors in each of the areas.

As a result of your feedback, we have made several changes, these include:

- Our Repairs hot line will be providing reference numbers for all calls made; this will allow clients to follow-up inquiries at a later date.
- All services, including the Repairs hot line are now asking if you would like us to call you back on your mobile phone. This is aimed at reducing the cost for you to contact Housing Plus.
